

MINUTES STREATOR COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING
PROCEEDINGS OF THE STREATOR CITY COUNCIL
HELD AT 204 S. BLOOMINGTON STREET, STREATOR, ILLINOIS
FEBRUARY 13, 2018

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Lansford called the meeting to order at 1:30 P.M.

ROLL CALL Members present: Bedei, Brozak, Crouch, Scarbeary and Mayor Lansford.

Staff members present: Wrighton, Chief Bird, Dept Chief Turner, Palm, Henderson and Lucas.

PUBLIC COMMENT None.

DISCUSSION ITEMS-

1. Review Dispatch and Ambulance Response Data

Fire Chief Bird reported on the response data for emergency calls, repeat callers, and fall victims. There is still a need to reduce non-emergency calls. There was discussion regarding Mobile Integrated Health and a decision has been made to award ALS designation to OSF Streator Center for Health.

2. Fire Training Facility Update

Fire Chief Bird reviewed the plans and layout of the training facility with the Council. The Council approved the plans.

3. Street Lighting/Fire Department Lighting Upgrades

Wrighton presented this item to the Council. After discussion the Council decided to go ahead and begin Phase I of this project which is replacing the city owned street lights with LED lighting. We will negotiate with Com Ed for the other 85% of lights in town. One question asked was can we use TIF money to replace street lights in the City?

4. Solid Waste Contract Revisions

The current city waste contract expires May 1, 2018. Dave Schaab, Waste Management Marketing Manager, presented a pilot program at the cost of \$1.30 per resident to pick up electronic recycling and household chemical waste. The council decided to put the waste management out to bid.

5. Disposition & Close-Out of Streator's CDBG Revolving Loan Fund

Jeremy Palm, City Engineer, presented options to the Council for closing-out the CDBG funds.

The option chosen by the Council to use for the close-out was to fund the Barlow Addition Sewer Project and the remainder of the funds will be used for a road paving project to be determined.

6. Administrative Adjudication of Selected Ordinance Violations

Wrighton presented this item to the Council for discussion after researching the possibility of convening an administrative adjudication process in the City of Streator as an option to increase revenue. It was the Council's desire to keep monitoring the neighboring communities that are using this structure and revisit this issue at a later time.

COMMENTS

Councilman Scarbeary asked the Council to consider hiring a different actuary to work with the Fire and Police Pension.

ADJOURNMENT

With no further discussion, Mayor Lansford called for a motion to adjourn the meeting.

Scarbeary made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Brozak.
