

**MINUTES SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
PROCEEDINGS OF THE STREATOR CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
MARCH 30, 2018 AT 8:30 A.M.**

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Lansford called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

ROLL CALL: Members present: Bedei, Brozak, Crouch, Scarbeary and Mayor Lansford.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: No one requested to speak.

NEW BUSINESS

1. RESOLUTION 2018-15. APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT AGREEMENT IN WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT, INC. SOLID WASTE, RECYCLING AND YARD WASTE SCAVENGERS AND ELECTRONIC AND HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL PICK-UP.

Scot Wrighton, City Manager, presented this item to the Council with revisions that still need to be made to the contract. 1) The Public Works Director has the authority to order replacement by WMI of garbage containers. 2) Correct the typos regarding the Troy Fire District. 3) Include the Streator Incubator in the city's dumpster service. 4) Waste Management reserves the right to increase rates if it is mandated by the government, but the city reserves the right to terminate the contract in 90 days as a result of increases to the city rates. Mayor Lansford called for motion and second to approve the revisions and the contract with Waste Management, Inc. and the City of Streator.

MOTION: Brozak made a motion to approve the motion and revisions to the contract with Waste Management, Inc.; seconded by Crouch.

ROLL: Ayes: Bedei, Brozak, Crouch, Scarbeary and Mayor Lansford.

2. ORDINANCE 2018- 12. AUTHORIZING AND ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF STREATOR MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 3, REVENUE AND FINANCE, SECTION 3.48, FEES AND DEPOSITS FOR CITY SERVICES (SEWER AND SOLID WASTE)

Wrighton presented this item to the Council explaining that the city decreased the garbage pick-up to \$22.00 in 2018. The city would like to increase that to \$23.00/month because the new concierge service pilot program charge will be \$1.30 per residence and the increase back to \$23.00/month would be a fair compromise to our citizens. Mayor Lansford called for a motion and second to approve the ordinance in support of increasing the garbage fee to \$23.00/month.

MOTION: Crouch made a motion to adopt and support the ordinance to increase the garbage fee per month to \$23.00; seconded by Scarbeary.

ROLL: Ayes: Bedei, Brozak, Crouch, Scarbeary and Mayor Lansford.

3. RESOLUTION 2018-16. SELECTING CERTAIN GROUP HEALTH PROVIDERS FOR THE EMPLOYEE INSURANCE BENEFITS PROGRAM.

Wrighton presented this item to the Council explaining the differences in deductibles and rates for employee health insurance. Mayor Lansford requested a motion and second to remain with Blue Cross Blue Shield for medical coverage \$2,500 deductible for now and let the new Health Benefits Committee have more discussion, and we will revisit this issue at a later date in the year.

MOTION: Crouch made a motion to remain with Blue Cross Blue Shield for employee health insurance for the time being; seconded by Brozak.

ROLL: Ayes: Bedei, Brozak, Crouch, Scarbeary and Mayor Lansford.

ADJOURNMENT:

With no further items for discussion, Mayor Lansford requested a motion to adjourn the special meeting.

MOTION: Brozak made a motion to close the public hearing; seconded by Scarbeary.

ROLL: Ayes: Bedei, Brozak, Crouch, Scarbeary and Mayor Lansford.
