

ORDINANCE 2017-06

AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF STREATOR, LA SALLE AND LIVINGSTON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, TITLE 3 "REVENUE AND FINANCE", CHAPTER 3.48 "FEES AND DEPOSITS FOR CITY SERVICES", SECTION 3.48.070 "SEWER AND SOLID WASTE"

WHEREAS, the Streator Municipal Code, Title 3, Chapter 3.48 establishes certain fees and deposits for City Services; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code of the City of Streator defines sewer connection (tap) fees for the connection to the City's sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of amending the City sewer connection (tap) fee provision following construction of an 8" sanitary sewer line along Groveland Avenue; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Streator, LaSalle and Livingston Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The Streator Municipal Code Chapter 3.48 "Fees and Deposits for City Services" be and the same is hereby amended by deleting said section and adding new Section 3.48.070(C) as follows:

"Section 3.48.070(C)

C. Sewer (Tap) Connection Fee. That effective April 1, 2009, the connection fee for each sanitary sewer connection (tap) shall be not less than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) of the actual cost of extending the sewer line to the property served, except for connection fees established pursuant to grant-funded projects and as follows:

- 1. Connection fee for 8" sanitary sewer line whose downstream end begins at sanitary MH P2048 125 feet north of Groveland Avenue on Eastwood Avenue and then extends 525 feet west along Groveland Avenue from Eastwood Avenue and then terminates 150' north of Groveland Avenue on a rear yard easement behind 10 Maplewood shall be \$9,500.

Section 2: Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 3: That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all chapters and articles and sections of the Streator Municipal Code shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect immediately upon publication and shall be incorporated into the Streator Municipal Code.
