PROCEEDINGS OF THE STREATOR CITY COUNCIL AND REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
AT 7:00 P.M, JUNE 17, 2015 HELD AT THE CITY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING COUNCIL ROOM

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Lansford presiding.

ROLL CALL: Members present: Bedei, Brozak, Crouch, Phelan and Mayor Lansford.

PROCLAMATION: Mayor Lansford read a proclamations regarding bicycle safety and proclaimed June 20th through June 27th Bike Safety Week in Streator.

RECOGNITION: Mayor Lansford gave recognition on the retirement of Fire Chief Tom Risley and Public Works Director David Fussell for their years of service to the city.

PUBLIC COMMENT: E. J. Flannigan, 4th of July Committee member, announced that they would be hosting a fundraiser at Pizza Hut on Wednesday June 24th and asked citizens show their support.

Janice Green, 107 East Bridge Street, announced that Streator Grade School Band-aid's were hosting an event touring Weber Gardens on June 28th from 1 to 4 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. ORDINANCE 2015/16-01. ORDINANCE ADOPTING PREVAILING WAGE RATES TO BE PAID TO LABORERS, MECHANICS AND OTHER WORKERS PERFORMING CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS IN THE CITY OF STREATOR, LA SALLE AND LIVINGSTON COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

Mayor Lansford presented the item for consideration.

MOTION: Crouch made a motion to approve the ordinance; seconded by Brozak.

Jeremy Palm, City Engineer, reported on the item. Councilman Phelan stated his reasons for disagreeing with prevailing wage. Following, the item passed upon the roll call vote.

10. MOTION TO RECEIVE AND PLACE ON FILE CITY COUNCIL POLICY ON USE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR PUBLIC EVENTS

City Manager Wrighton, stated that the item should have been to “approve” the City Council policy not receive and place on file. Wrighton asked Council if the motion was the same to approve. Council unanimously agreed that the vote was to *approve* it as a policy for the City.

MOTION: Brozak made a motion to approve the consent agenda with a fund warrant total of \$961,224.26. The motion was seconded by Bedei.

- Gave a personal thanks to retiring Public Works Director, David Fussell and announced that Larry Hake would be taking the position over beginning June 29th.

OTHER CITY OFFICIALS: Council reminded citizens of upcoming events taking place in town and congratulated and thanked the two retiring city employees for their years of service to the city.

ADJOURNMENT

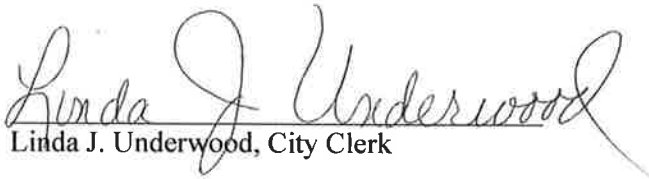
With no further items for discussion, Mayor Lansford requested a motion and second to adjourn the meeting.
