

ORDINANCE 2016-20

APPROVING AND AWARDED A "FAÇADE GRANT" IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000
TO STREATOR ELKS #591, OWNER IN CONNECTION WITH A FAÇADE UPGRADE
AT 202 NORTH PARK STREET

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2016, the City Council of the City of Streator, adopted Ordinance 2016-03 "Streator Downtown Building Façade Renovation And Replacement Grant And Loan Program For Streator Tax Increment Financing District II"; and

WHEREAS, the program seeks to incentivize owners to make improvements to commercial storefronts of commercial buildings which face City streets within the Streator Downtown Area; and

WHEREAS, Streator Elks #291 , owner of property at 202 North Park Street submitted an application for a façade grant in connection with an upgrade to their building at 202 North Park Street; and

WHEREAS, the project consists of:

- Replacement of all south façade windows (those not currently bricked closed) with windows of a larger size to fill the original window opening size
- Replacement of the existing railing on the east facade
- Restoration of the existing neon sign on the south facade
- Restoration of the steel support beam on the east facade and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer determined that the work being done is consistent with the purpose and intent of the façade program and has recommended approval of the grant application; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of September 13, 2016, the Plan Commission did review the grant application and determined the project met with the conditions and intentions of the program; and

WHEREAS the Plan Commission, through Plan Commission Recommendation 2016-03 which is attached hereto (Exhibit A) and made a part hereof this ordinance, did recommend approval of the façade grant in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$15,000) to Streator Elks #591, owners of 202 North Park Street, Streator, Illinois.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Streator, LaSalle and Livingston Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: The City Council of the City of Streator has determined that the submitted façade grant application, attached as Exhibit B to this ordinance, by Streator Elks #591., meets the necessary requirements to receive a grant in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$15,000.00).

Section 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to execute said façade grant application (Exhibit B) to Streator Elks #591, owners, in connection with the:

- Replacement of all south façade windows (those not currently bricked closed) with windows of a larger size to fill the original window opening size
- Replacement of the existing railing on the east facade
- Restoration of the existing neon sign on the south facade
- Restoration of the steel support beam on the east facade and

at property legally described as: Town of Streator Lot 12 Block 9, and more commonly known as 202 North Park Street



PLAN COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION 2016-02

RECOMMENDING APPROVAL AND GRANTING AWARD OF A "FAÇADE GRANT" TO STREATOR ELKS, OWNERS, 202 NORTH PARK STREET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000.00.

WHEREAS, Streator Elks, owners of property at 202 North Park Street submitted an application for a façade grant in connection with a façade upgrade to their building at 202 North Park Street; and

WHEREAS, the project will consist of replacement of all south façade windows (those not currently bricked closed) with windows of a larger size to fill the original window opening size, replacement of the existing railing on the east façade, restoration of the existing neon sign on the south façade, and restoration of the steel support beam on the east facade at 202 North Park Street; and

WHEREAS, the work is an eligible cost under the program due to the fact that the project plan seeks to renovate the building facades to a look consistent with the pre- 1950s look of the building; and

WHEREAS, at the Plan Commission meeting of September 13, 2016, the Plan Commission did review the grant application and determined the project met with the conditions and intentions of the program; and

WHEREAS the Plan Commission of the City of Streator has considered all evidence, both written and oral;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Plan Commission of the City of Streator, LaSalle and Livingston Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: The Plan Commission has determined that the submitted façade grant application, attached as Exhibit A to this recommendation, by Streator Elks meets the necessary requirements to receive the grant amount of \$15,000.00.

Section 2: That the Plan Commission recommends approval to the City Council of the City of Streator that a "façade grant" be issued for replacement of all south façade windows (those not currently bricked closed) with windows of a larger size to fill the original window opening size, replacement of the existing railing on the east façade, restoration of the existing neon sign on the south façade, and restoration of the steel support beam on the east facade at 202 North Park Street and legally described as:

TOWN OF STREATOR LOT 12 BLK 9

Section 3: That this recommendation be immediately be transmitted together with a copy of the minutes of said meeting to the City Council for final review and approval.
